Quindici delle famiglie del "Progetto-Sololo" dei villaggi di Mado adhi e Waye godha, hanno intrapreso piccole attività agricole quali fonti di reddito. La Green House del Villaggio Obbitu fa scuola in collaborazione con Aphiplus e con personale del Governo.

## WAYE GODA AND MADODADI AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITIES

**In Madoadi**, they use drip line irrigation to grow vegetables like sukuma wiki, Spinach, bulb onions, and carrots. They had small plot from concern food security project in Mado adhi. The project was abandoned by the community. We provided 150m of drip line for 8MX15M area. We also provided 200litre container for storage and irrigation. They will put water manually and through the raised water tank do irrigation through gravitational force. 3 of the mebers were hard working and have harvested sukuma wiki already. They partly eat and also sell some locally within madoadhi.

**In Wayegoda**, there was an abandoned green house constructed by FHK marsabit for the last 3 years. It never worked for the beneficiaries. We revived the green house by training our beneficiriness through ministry of agriculture, provided 2 donkeys for fetching water from the Waye goda dam. We also provided 150M irrigation drip adequate for 10 rows of 8MX15. They already have the tank. They are planting tomatoes, spinach, and sukuma wiki in the green house. They have already harvested and sold several bundles. The activity was supported by Aphiplus project.
