The Department of children's services has been collaborating with the OVC project since 2010. The project comprises;

The home based care target needy orphans and vulnerable children residing with their caregivers. The project has touched the lives of over 400 children. With addition support, many more children can be reached.

Obittu children's home admits needy children through our approval. The institution has a current population of 19 children [12 boys and 7 girls]. The home is registered and in compliance with the charitable children's institutions regulation of 2005 [Registration number CS NO. 000636].
