


- 2.4 The proponent shall ensure that the cooling systems fitted have zero ozone depleting potential as per the Environmental Management and Coordination (Controlled Substances) Regulation of 2007.
- 2.5 The proponent shall ensure that construction is done as per the approved drawings in adherence to the provisions of the Building Code of Kenya of 1968 and supervised by qualified personnel.
- 2.6 The proponent shall ensure that design drawings for the water and sewerage reticulation system are submitted to the relevant authorities for evaluation and approval before commencement of works.
- 2.7 The proponent shall ensure that the project will not encroach on any way-leave and will leave the required space for such services.
- 2.8 The proponent shall design and implement a concise traffic management plan duly approved by the County Engineer, prior to commencement of the project, to avoid traffic congestion.
- 2.9 The proponent shall ensure that all excavated material and debris is collected, re-use and where need be disposed off as per the Environmental Management and Coordination (Waste Management) Regulations, 2006.
- 2.10 The proponent shall ensure strict adherence to the provisions of Environmental Management and Coordination (Noise and Excessive Vibrations Pollution Control) Regulations, 2009.
- 2.11 The proponent shall ensure strict adherence to the provisions of National Construction Act of 2011.
- 2.12 The proponent shall ensure strict adherence to the Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA) of 2007.
- 2.13 The proponent shall ensure that workers are provided with adequate personal protection equipment (PPE), sanitary facilities as well as adequate training.
- 2.14 The proponent shall ensure that construction activities are undertaken during the day (and not at night) - between 0800 hrs and 1700 hrs; and that transportation of construction materials to and from site is undertaken during weekdays (and not weekends) off peak hours.
- 2.15 The proponent shall after completion of the civil works ensure that the site is restored to its initial status;
- 2.16 The proponent shall ensure strict adherence to the Environmental Management Plan developed throughout the project cycle.
- 3.0 Operational Conditions**
- 3.1 The proponent shall obtain an effluent discharge license from NEMA for the proposed waste water treatment plant within the first year of operation the Environmental Management and Coordination (Water Quality) Regulations of 2006.
- 3.2 The proponent shall ensure that all waste water is disposed as per the standards set out in the Environmental Management and Coordination (Water Quality) Regulations of 2006.
