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THE REPORT FOR EYE MEDICAL CAMP AT SOLOLO MISSION HOSPITAL



INTRODUCTION

The medical eye and dental camp was sponsored by MEAK and partnered with the area member of parliament under the Constituency Development fund CDF. Sololo mission Hospital provided the facilities for free. The medical camp lasted for ten days from 01/09/2024 to 10/09/2024. The role of CDF was to conduct mobilization and sensitization of the population in Solo sub county, Moyale and Marsabit communities. The mobilization was through public address system, social media and through local leaders.

Services offered included eye screening, operation for cataract, treatment of eye infection and other conditions and provision of reading glasses. For the dental services it was mainly tooth extraction.



Our program conducted mobilization of the HBC beneficiaries and the elderly beneficiaries. HBC beneficiaries were sensitize during food distribution for August and a follow up mobilization conducted by Abdi for 3 days moving from 1 village to the other and conducting home visits.

The message was for all



beneficiaries with an EYE problem to go for the screening at Sololo Mission Hospital from 1/09/2024 to 10th September 2024. The screening will help you know the problem and the advice given by the eye specialist. The services were free and there was no payment. The elderly beneficiaries were visited by Mr. Gufu guyo during the monitoring photos and were sensitized to visit the eye medical camp at Sololo mission hospital to go for eye screening and seek treatment and advices from the specialist. Mr Paul Guyo visited the 27 elderly at home and conducted screening and referred 9 elderly.

14 people came for screening, 2 of them were operated for cataract. Others were treated with eye drops, while 3 were service due to the condition cannot be operated or it has a permanent damage. They were advised to go home. The table below summarizes the people who attended the eye and dental camp

In summary the total number of beneficiaries who came for screenings were 14

HBC beneficiaries – 6

Elderly beneficiaries – 8

Operated -2

Treated and advised -6.

Mr. Paul and Abdi conducted monitoring as the patients started streaming in for screening and treatment and operation for continuous 3 days.

Paul would make follow up for the patients who were operated to observe success of the operation, treatment and advise.

COST OF MOBILIZATION AND MONITORING

CIPAD paid lunch allowance for Abdi and Paul for 6 days to cover mobilization and monitoring during the screening and operation sessions

The patients were paid transport back after coming for screening a rate of kshs 1000 per patients. A total of 14,000/= was spent on the patients and another 12,000/= on mobilization and monitoring

The total cost of the program was 26,000 kshs.

CONCLUSION

The program was very successful from the total attendance 2500 and the number operated 146. CIPAD beneficiaries were not many as per our target of 25 patients and their assistants. CIPAD appreciates that we were supported to participate in the mobilization and monitoring. And that our beneficiaries benefited from the exercise.

Paul was later engaged for screening and monitoring in the larger communities.

CIPAD is very grateful for the funding which facilitated our beneficiaries to access the services. The beneficiaries have expressed a heartfelt gratitude to be facilitated to attend the eye camp and transport back to their homes.
